Senior Home

The campers made cards for one of the local Senior Residences in Rolling Meadows. These cards were made for the residents of the home and they receive them at random so they know people are thinking of them.

Ronald McDonald House Charities/St. Jude's

Campers participated in collecting pop tabs for Ronald McDonald House Charities. We collect the pop tabs and donate them to the Ronald McDonald Charity where they recycle them for money which is added to their operating budget and allows them to continue providing "home-away-from-home" for the children and families of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. The camp collected approximately 2,000 pop tabs this summer!

Lutheran General and St. Alexius Child Life Department

The campers made "I Spy" bottles to donate to the Child Life Department at both Lutheran General and St. Alexius in Hoffman Estates. These bottles are used in the Pediatric and Emergency Departments to keep the children entertained while waiting.

WINGS – Women In Need Grower Stronger

Campers collected items to donate to WINGS. WINGS helps homeless and abused women and children by offering integrated services that meet their needs for shelter, education, guidance and support. Some of the items collected were diapers, wipes, cleaning supplies, food, first aid supplies, and more.

Palatine Food Pantry

This year at camp we held a food drive. The campers brought in food for the Palatine food pantry which also serves Rolling Meadows residents. The food pantry is a source of nutrition that serves senior citizens, the disabled and low income families. Presently, the pantry is serving 265 families. Most of the food in the pantry comes from donations from individuals and from food drives sponsored by schools, churches, civic groups and businesses.
