

## **Rolling Meadows Park District Tennis Programs**

The Rolling Meadows Tennis Program has received rave reviews. The programs are under the direction of the Frank Sacks Tennis Camps, Inc. The United States Tennis Association honored Mr. Sacks in 2006 as a Grassroots Tennis Hero (**USTA**) for his contribution to the growth of tennis in the United States. In 2008, the **Chicago Tribune** did a feature article about Mr. Sacks and the Frank Sacks Tennis Camps, Inc. and called Mr. Sacks “a driving force in the growth of tennis in the north and northwest suburbs.”

The RMPD tennis program has again been expanded to offer classes for youth and adults at all levels based on the National Tennis Rating Program. In addition, there will be special adult weekend programs. The Rolling Meadows Park District Tennis Program offers an excellent opportunity to receive professional tennis instruction at a fraction of the costs charged by private clubs and resorts.

Director of Tennis, Frank Sacks and Wendy McKinney, Plum Grove Park Supervisor will oversee the tennis programs. Mr. Sacks is a certified USPTA/PTR professional and former Head Men's and Women's Coach at Northeastern Illinois University. His staff is comprised of top area tennis teaching professionals and collegiate tennis players who specially trained in his innovative tennis teaching methods. The Rolling Meadows Park District tennis programs are a great value because of the following reasons:

1. All youth and adult lessons and youth camps will be taught by certified USPTA/USPTR tennis professionals/and or trained collegiate players.
  
2. Youth programs will include convenient 2-week programs held at various parks along with our regular 5-week programs. Pee Wee Tennis will now be offered for ages 4 to 6. We are offering new morning youth Tennis Camps in addition to our popular afternoon tennis camp programs.
  
3. The adult weekend specials will include Instant Tennis (for beginner to low intermediate) and the Adult Tennis Camp (for low intermediate to advanced).
  
4. All adult classes have been reorganized by level and NTRP ratings to help tennis players find the proper ability level. This should help insure maximum enjoyment and quality of all classes.
  
5. All adult and youth class level descriptions have been revised to make it easier to select the proper classes.
