Camp Registration and Payment Information

Starting January 2, we will begin taking 2012 camp registrations. Payment plans will only be offered with automatic withdrawal via credit cards. All camp programs must be paid in full at the time of registration if not choosing the payment plan. All camp participants are required to fill out a Camper Information Packet prior to the start of camp. Individual Week option registration begins Monday, June 4th, upon availability.

Session 1 and Session 2 payments are due by Friday, June 1 at 4pm

Session 3 payment is due by Friday, June 29 at 4pm
