

# ROLLING MEADOWS PARK DISTRICT PARKS & PICNIC GUIDE

Rolling Meadows Park District parks are ideal sites for group or individual picnicking. Picnickers will enjoy the natural beauty of the parks as well as some of the amenities our parks offer. Picnic permits are offered through the Park Central Administrative Office. Permits for families or groups less than 20 are not required, however, permits do guarantee a designated picnic site. Without a permit, picnic areas are available on a first come, first served basis. Groups without a picnic permit must yield picnic areas to permitted groups.

**RESERVATION POLICY** - Large group picnics require a permit. Permits are available for Rolling Meadows Park District residents beginning the first business Monday in January. In-person registration for permits is taken at Park Central, 3000 Central Rd. City of Rolling Meadows residents who are not Rolling Meadows Park District residents and nonresidents may make reservations beginning April 1. Contracts will be mailed to the party responsible for the group and must be completed and signed, including the waiver, by the adult (21 years or older) who assumes responsibility for the group.

**SECURITY DEPOSIT** - The security deposit for use of our picnic sites is \$500.00. This deposit is refundable. The security deposit is our insurance against damage to the park or excessive clean up. Groups hosting more participants than indicated on the permit will also forfeit their security deposit. Deposit refunds will be made after the park site has been inspected. The district reserves the right to assess additional charges for any abuse of the park/picnic site. Groups of more than 150 will be required to post a security deposit equal to the total value of the picnic permit.

**PICNIC PACKS** - Picnic Packs are available for a \$5.00 rental fee per day. The picnic pack includes: softball bats, softball, throw down bases and a volleyball. A security deposit of \$50.00 is required.

## GENERAL RULES

[1] All functions conducted in Rolling Meadows Park District parks must be held in accordance with district ordinances, policies and rules.

[2] Observe closing Hours.

[3] Alcoholic beverages are allowed **ONLY** with the approval of the Park Board Commissioners. (Alcohol permitted in cans or unbreakable containers only.) Liquor Liability Insurance *is required. This insurance policy may be purchased through the park district or through your own agent. Proof of purchase is required before the event.*

[4] Vehicles are restricted to designated parking lots and are not allowed on grassy areas, unless permission has been given by the park district. *Police will ticket vehicles parked on grassy areas not displaying an authorized parking permit.*

[5] Loud or boisterous language or behavior is not permitted. No fogging for insects!

[6] A picnic permit does not mean the park is closed to the general public; courtesy to other groups is expected. Permits give exclusive rights to tables and pavilions.

[7] Area must be cleaned up after picnic.

[8] Fires are not permitted without permission from the Park Board of Commissioners as well as a special use permit from the Rolling Meadows Fire Department. Grilling is always permitted in acceptable containers.

[9] Tent or canopy use requires permission from the Park Board of Commissioners as well as a special use permit from the City Of Rolling Meadows Building and Zoning Department on tents larger than 20'X20' or for more than 4 days use in parks.

[10] Special permission needed for bands and DJ's in any parks.

[11] Picnic groups of 75 or more are required to pay for a park supervisor at \$15.00 per hour.

## PERMITTED PICNIC SITES

### **Kimball Hill Park** [8]

Kimball Hill Park is 25 acres or developed park land. Kimball Hill Park is suitable for picnics of up to 200 people. There is an open-sided picnic shelter, twenty-five picnic tables, sand volleyball court, playground, gazebo, pond, walking/bicycle path and ball fields.

### **Roger Florey Park** [6]

Florey Park is a park area divided by Salt Creek. The picnic grove is a picturesque park area that is suitable for picnics up to 125 people. The picnic grove has sixteen picnic tables and a sand volleyball court. On the opposite side of the creek there is a playground, tennis courts and ball field.

### **Waverly Park** [11]

Waverly Park is suitable for picnics of up to 50 people. Waverly Park has a gazebo, tennis courts, a roller blade area, playground equipment and ball field.
